1000 Books Before Kindergarten



The concept is simple, the rewards are priceless! Read a book (any book) to your newborn, infant, and/or toddler. The goal is to read 1,000 books (yes, you can repeat books) before your child starts kindergarten. Reading regularly with young children

stimulates development and strengthens parent-child relationships to build language, literacy and social-emotional skills that last a lifetime

Read 1000 Books – Receive a Prize

Track your books any way you want – pick up a paper log at the library or use the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten app. When your child reaches a milestone (100, 200, 300 books, etc.) come to the library to get a sticker and take a photo with us. At 1000 books, your child receives a certificate and a book prize to keep
